Gallaudet College is being visited by an increasing number of professionals from the Caribbean Region. The Jamaican Association of the Deaf is sponsoring the visits of Jeanne Robinson, Willifred Mae Hall, and Carol Mitchell. Mrs. Robinson, the Executive Officer of the JAD will be at Gallaudet for meetings during the first week of August. Mrs. Winnifred Mae Hall, teacher of deaf children and involved in teacher training, will be a participant in the Department of Administration's Special Topics Seminar on Middle Management Personnel. Ms. Mitchell, the Auditory Technician for the JAD, is enrolled in summer classes in an attempt to upgrade her skills in that field.
